



UNIFORM

All uniform items, with the exception of shoes, are to be purchased from the College Uniform Shop.

Summer Uniform (Term 1 and Term 4)

The uniform as set out above may be worn at this time.

Boys:

- College Blazer
- College Open-Neck, Short Sleeved White Pinstripe Shirt
- College Navy Blue Shorts
- College Navy Blue Long Trousers
- College Jumper
- College Marle Blue Socks
- Black Leather Shoes
- School Hat/Cap/Bucket Hat – Year 7

Girls:

- College Blazer
- College Summer Dress
- College Jumper
- College Navy Blue Winter Skirt
- College Open-Neck, Short Sleeved White Pinstripe Shirt
- College Blue Socks (if wearing the Winter Skirt)
- Black Leather Shoes
- School Hat/Cap/Bucket Hat – Year 7

Winter Uniform period (Term 2 and 3):

Due to the climate, winter uniform may be worn throughout the year. It is also the formal dress uniform for official functions of the College.

Boys:

- College Blazer
- College Long Sleeved, White Pinstripe Shirt and College Tie (or Senior College Tie)
- College Jumper
- College Navy Blue Long Trousers
- Black or Navy Socks
- Black Leather Shoes

Girls:

- College Blazer
- College Long Sleeved, White Pinstripe Shirt and College Tie (or Senior College Tie)
- College Jumper
- College Navy Blue Skirt
- Navy Blue Tights
- College Navy Blue Long Trousers (Optional)
- Black Leather Shoes

Shoes:

Enclosed leather shoes, that cover the feet, are essential for reasons of health and safety. Shoes must be plain black polished leather. Suede, boots, skate/sneaker, ballet slipper style shoes and loafers are not permitted. Shoes must have a low/medium heel, but not wedge or platform heel.

Throughout the Year

The blazer is a compulsory part of the uniform to be worn to and from school everyday and at Assembly. During the school day the blazer need not be worn.

On wet days the optional spray-jacket may be worn to and from school over the blazer.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS UNIFORM

The following uniform is compulsory for Physical Education classes.

Girls:

College navy blue skirt or pant, College navy blue skort **or** College navy blue shorts.
College polo top.

Boys: College navy blue shorts.
College polo top.

- College navy track suit jacket and track suit pants may be worn during Physical Education classes.
- Footwear should be appropriate to the activity or sport and include correct College socks in those sports where team socks are required.
- On Carnival Days (Swimming Carnival, Athletics Carnival, Cross Country) students must wear
either
The College track suit jacket and track pants over their House Physical Education uniform (or a plain house coloured top may replace the College polo top).
or
The normal school uniform complete with blazer.
- When representing the College in carnivals or team sports the College navy track suit and must be worn over the appropriate sports uniform.
- When competing for the school in swimming events students must wear College bathers. When competing for the school in other sports, school skirts and pants or shorts must be worn with the appropriate tops and footwear, unless the rules and traditions of the sport require something different.

GUIDELINES FOR CASUAL DAYS

On designated casual clothes days, students must wear clothing which respects their own dignity and that of others in the College community. The guidelines below reflect the required standard.

- Unsuitable clothing includes low-cut, see-through or overly short garments (including tops, shorts and skirts); clothing printed with offensive statements or slogans;
- Jewellery, hair and make-up should not be excessive. Long hair should be tied back for some practical lessons.
- Closed shoes only must be worn. Thongs, open sandals and slip on shoes are not appropriate for reasons of safety.

EXPECTATIONS REGARDING PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Students are to be correctly and neatly dressed at all times, in the appropriate uniform. It is expected that students will take pride in their uniform, as they are recognised by it, and their appearance is a reflection on themselves and their College.

If a student arrives at school out of the normal uniform, a note of explanation must be presented to the Pastoral Care Group Leader who will sign it, then allow the student to carry it during the day for further use if required.

1. **Hair:** Hair must be neat and tidy at all times and in a style appropriate to wearing with the College uniform. Dreadlocks and clip on hair extensions are not permitted. Hair is to be worn off the face. In some subjects it is a requirement that long hair is tied up with an elastic band. If ribbons, scrunchies or clips are worn they are to be navy blue, plain and not showy. Hair may be dyed, however, unnatural colours are not acceptable. If in doubt, before colouring please check with your Pastoral Care Group Leader.
2. Years 7-10 boys are to be clean shaven. Senior College boys may have a neatly trimmed beard or moustache.
3. **Make-up:** Make-up is not encouraged; however, if worn, is limited to minimal foundation e.g. tinted moisturiser and/or mascara. It should not be obvious. Nail polish may not be worn with the uniform. Eyeliner, eyeshadow, blush and lipstick are not acceptable.
4. **Jewellery:** Students may wear one plain bracelet and/or ring. Plain studs or sleepers may be worn with pierced ears. No more than 2 earrings may be worn in the lobe (only) of each ear. No other facial piercing is acceptable, including tongue piercing.
5. Body piercing and tattooing must be covered up for **all school** activities.
6. **Blazers** are to be worn travelling to and from school and at College assemblies.
7. **Dresses and skirts must be an appropriate length.**
8. **Marking of Clothes:** All items of clothing must be clearly marked. (Woven names are recommended or a name printed clearly with a permanent marking pen.)
